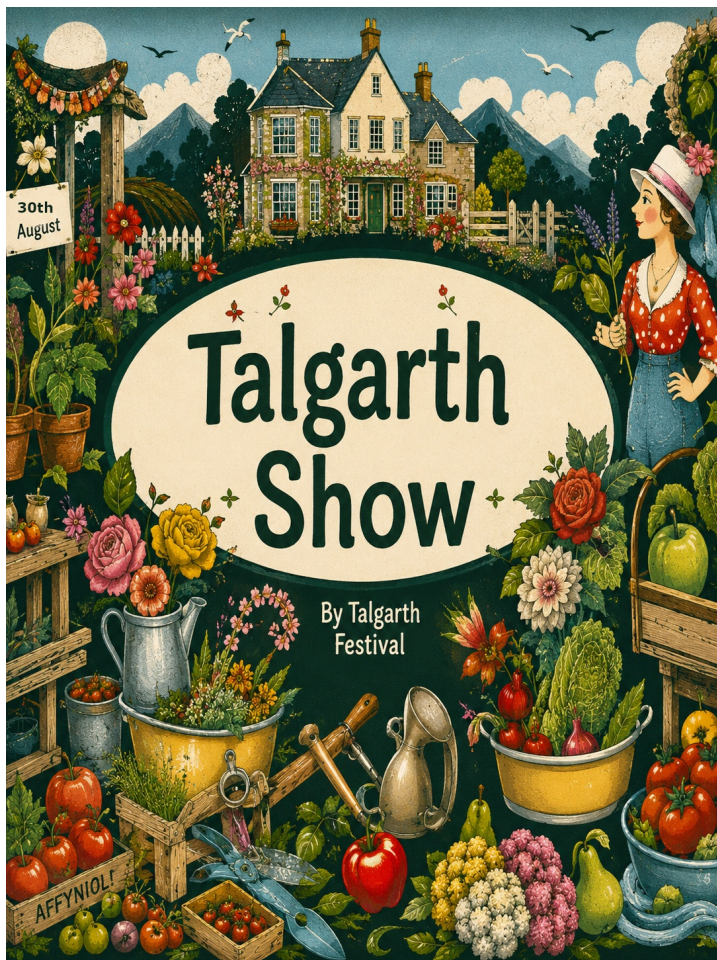

Class 1A—Talgarth and The Black Mountains Vegetable Challenge

Create a display inspired by Talgarth, the Black Mountains, or the surrounding area using vegetables only.

Any vegetable may be used, no artificial decorations. Vegetables may be cut, carved or shaped. Judged on creativity, presentation, originality and use of vegetables.



Class 1B - Top Vase

The top vase class is for a vase of mixed flowering stems containing a total of between 5 and 10 stems, taken from a minimum of 2 different kinds of plants, 2 varieties of the same plant are not 2 kinds.

Eg Pinks, Carnations & Sweet William are all Dianthus, would not be classed as different kinds. It will be judged for colour, form, condition, quality and freshness, and viewed from all directions. No accessories or additional foliage allowed.

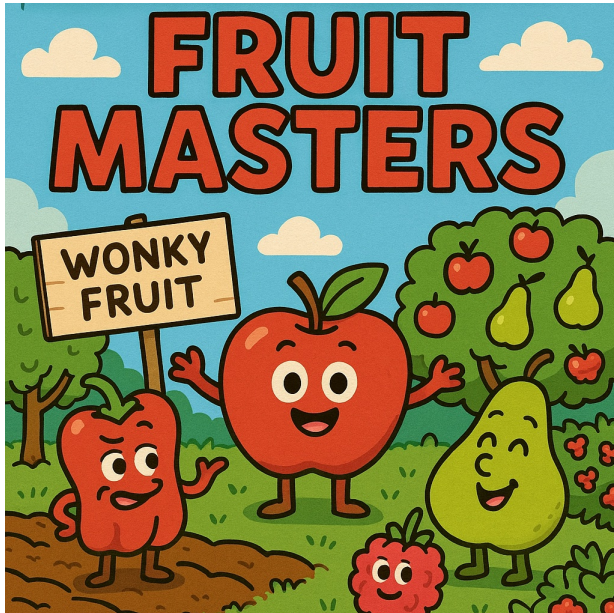

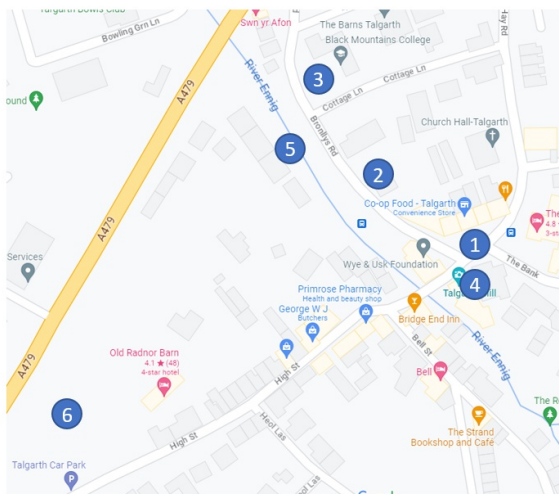
