Class 1A—Top Tray

The top tray class is for a collection of 3 types of vegetables from the below:

Carrots (3 number), Onions (3 number), Potatoes (3 number), Runner Beans (6 pods), Tomatoes (6 number), Sweetcorn (2 number), Cucumber (2 number), Beetroot (3 number).

The vegetables will be displayed for effect within an area measuring 18x24inches without bending any part of them.



Class 1B - Top Vase

The top vase class is for a vase of mixed flowering stems containing a total of between 5 and 10 stems, taken from a minimum of 2 different kinds of plants, 2 varieties of the same plant are not 2 kinds.

Eg Pinks, Carnations & Sweet William are all Dianthus, would not be classed as different kinds.

It will be judged for colour, form, condition, quality and freshness, and viewed from all directions.

No accessories or additional foliage allowed.
